Commencement of Academic Session

 - 3.) You may have already communicated with hostel authorities for hostel accommodation in the campus. Strictly adhere to the regulations of the hostels. Violation of regulations may lead to disciplinary action/ expulsion from the hostel.

- 4.) The MBBS course is a stressful period and some of you may face adjustment issues related to study, staying away from home etc. A counselling cell is established in the college for this purpose whom you are free to approach at any time.
 - 5.) This institution observes zero tolerance for issues pertaining to ragging and gender discrimination for which appropriate cells are functioning.
 - 6.) We have a well-endowed library with text books and reference books for issue and a good stock of international and national journals which you should utilize for your advancement.
